Homework:

- 3. Reading: your child will be expected to read 4 times at home independently and write it in their diaries.
- 4. Topic homework menus: your child can pick any 6 activities to do in their homework books over the course of the whole term. Children should be encouraged to bring any completed homework into school for me to see before the end of term.

All other homework will be kept in their homework folders which must be brought back into school every Friday. Diaries and reading books must be in school everyday. Diaries will be checked every Monday.
