

MUSIC EXPECTATIONS

End of KS1

I can sing or play a short musical pattern keeping a steady pulse.

I can create sounds and put them together so that my piece has a beginning, middle and end.

I can talk about pitch, rhythm, loud music, soft music and the speed of the music.

I can act on musical instructions and I can draw shapes to show the sounds I have made.

End of LKS2

I can sing a song in tune and perform a simple rhythm part using a short range of notes.

I can make up short patterns, repeat them and make up a group piece building up layers of sound.

I can talk about how the inter-related dimensions of music (pitch, rhythm, tempo, dynamics) affect the mood of the music.

I can use symbols to show the sounds I have created.

End of UKS2

I can sing a song in tune with expression showing awareness of the other parts and can perform a part from simple notation.

I can make up (compose) musical patterns using rhythm and melody, develop my ideas and organise them into a structure.

I can talk about different types of music and compare different types of music using musical vocabulary showing an understanding of the history of music.
