Class Information:

- Reading Books: Children can choose their reading books and may bring them in from home or choose from the class bookshelf. You may also be interested in looking at the top 100 books for Year 6 as it will give you a guide to the type of books your child should be reading.

Homework:

- Spellings each will be from the Y5/6 Spelling list. They will be given 10 each week and the test will also include 5 at random. Tests will be on Fridays. They must complete their spelling card on the 10 highlighted words.
- Maths/SPAG or Reading SATs practise questions will be given out each Friday to be handed in the following Friday. Your child will only receive two subjects each week, not all three.
- Reading: your child will be expected to read 4 times at home independently and write it in their diaries.
- Topic homework menus: your child can pick any 6 activities to do in their homework books over the course of the whole term. Children should be encouraged to bring any completed homework into school for me to see before the end of term.

All other homework will be kept in their homework folders which must be brought back into school every Friday. Diaries and reading books must be in school everyday. Diaries will be checked every Monday.
