Key skills by the end of Year 2:

1. Use the words: now, then, past, present, recently, decades and centuries.
2. Use time lines to order events, objects or significant people.
3. Use information about the past to describe the differences between then and now.
4. Look at books and pictures to help study the past.
5. Tell stories about the past and draw labelled diagrams to tell others about objects, people or events in the past.

Key skills by the end of Year 6:

1. Use words and phrases such as era, period, century, decade, Before Christ, AD, after, before, during, the passing of time..
2. Place the periods in history that they have studied on a timeline in the correct order.
3. Ask questions about change, cause, similarity and difference and significance.
4. Use speaking, writing, ICT, drama and drawing skills to make links, contrasts and connections between the eras studied.
5. Know that people both in the past and now have a point of view and that this can affect interpretation of the past.
