The Thrive Approach®

We are becoming a Thrive School! Mrs Wilkinson and Mrs Read are currently being trained to become Licensed Childhood Practitioners in The Thrive Approach. We hope to soon embed the approach across the whole school:

"The Thrive Approach has evolved over the last 25 years, providing those who work with children and young people with the knowledge, skills and tools to optimise social and emotional development. Thrive is committed to supporting and encouraging the development of confident, curious, creative and capable children and young people who are open to learning and better equipped to deal with life's ups and downs."

As part of our adoption of the Thrive Approach, we will carry out assessments of whole classes and individual children in relation to their social and emotional development. This assessment is automatically analysed, providing indicators of any particular areas for development and support. The results are used to guide the teacher or other adult as to the activities and teaching that would be useful for that class or child.

As part of the training, Mrs Wilkinson and Mrs Read have been holding Mindfulness sessions daily with various groups of children across the school. The children have engaged very well with these and many have reported feeling sunny, calm, happy and relaxed!
