


## **Thrive Room**

### Theme Day – All Around The World


Today we have had one of our theme days. Classes have been focusing on varying countries finding out about different aspects such as food, clothing and culture.

Apple – India, Oak – China, Willow – Japan, Beech – India, Cedar – Australia, Sycamore – A journey around the world












