In an evolving world, we are required to consider a number of potential risks and threats. All schools have been given guidance by NYCC, using the Counter Terrorism Security Office guidance in order to keep our school as safe as possible.

All school staff will be undergoing training next term and this will be followed by sessions teaching the children about what to do in the event of a risk / threat. In the meantime, we will be practicing a drill to ensure all staff and children know what to do in the event of a possible threat. This is similar to the 'Lock Down' procedure we already practice. At no point will we mention the threat of violence from people. We will use examples such as a dangerous animal or a dust cloud.
