Science	<p><u>Y1 The human body</u></p> <p>First, create an obstacle course in your house or garden. Remember to make it safe!</p> <p>Now try it out. Which obstacle is the hardest to get through? The easiest?</p> <p>What parts of your body are you using for each obstacle? Which parts are you stretching? Which do you have to make small? Which obstacles are easier or harder for your grown ups to do? I wonder why?</p>

	<p>Can you do an out loud commentary for your someone else trying out your course? Remember to describe all the different parts of the body they have to use.</p> <p>Finally, can you draw a picture of your obstacle course and label it with instructions to successfully complete each obstacle eg stretch your legs, use your arms to wiggle, curl your body up small.</p>
