<p><u>Weekly Theme: ‘Animals’</u></p> <p><i>This week you will be finding out about Animals. Art	<p><u>Pet Portrait</u></p> <p>Do you have a pet or a favourite animal? Can you draw/paint or collage a really careful picture of your pet or animal?</p> <p>Some pets won’t sit still for long, so you might need to take a photo and copy from that.</p>

Science - Classification	<p><u>Sorting Animals</u></p> <p>All animals are different and they can be sorted into groups depending on what they are like. Would you believe there are 13 different groups of Animals?</p> <p>You are going to be sorting animals in 5 of those groups. First of all, can you find out what each of the groups mean? What would an animal have to be like to fit into one of the groups?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Mammals (2) Reptiles (3) Amphibians (4) Fish (5) birds <p>On our class page there is a sorting animals activity. Have a go! Can you sort them all?</p> <p>Your final challenge: Can you find out what the other 8 groups are?</p>
