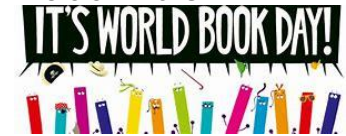

OAK – Reading and learning about “Handa’s Surprise”. Looking at different types of exotic fruits and using describing words.

WILLOW - In Science we have been learning about plants and seeds. In Maths we have been adding coins to make different amounts.

ASH - In Science we learnt about the job that each of the different parts of plants do.

BEECH - In Science we have been learning about sound. We found out that light travels faster than sound, and sound travels in waves and goes from your ear to your brain.

CHESTNUT - In Maths we have been learning the bus stop method for division. In art we have been looking at the Victorian printer William Morris and doing our own.
