Important Safety Messages

We have had occasions when children have been climbing on the school roof out of school hours. As it is dark, we have been unable to identify the children, but they could be primary age. Please talk to your children about the dangers of doing this. I will be contacting the police to alert them to this problem.

We have also been made aware that some KS2 children have been running across the main road outside school, sometimes deliberately in front of oncoming traffic, at the start and end of the school day. This is very concerning; there have been a couple of instances that have nearly caused serious accidents. We are regularly teaching the importance of road safety with the children in school, but please have the conversation with your children at home. If this continues, we will have to insist that children are accompanied to and from school.
