- If you have committed a criminal offence when you are 10 or over you can get arrested
- They talked to us about bullying, cyber bullying, antisocial behavior and vandalism
- If you did get arrested it could stop you from getting a job or travelling abroad
- Did you know you should be 13 to be on things like Snapchat, Instagram, and 16 to be on Whatsapp
- Anything you post on social media can be retraced even if you delete it
- You need to be thoughtful to other members of the village when you are playing out
- Bullying can affect you physically and mentally
- You should tell a trusted adult if you are or have seen someone get bullied
- Bullying is something that happens over and over, not just the once


