WHAT IS A CONTINENT?

Continents are large areas of land.

Continents contain many countries.

2. Which is the biggest continent?

Asia is the largest continent. It has the biggest **land area** and the world's biggest **population**.

There are 5 oceans:

Pacific Ocean
Atlantic Ocean
Indian Ocean
Arctic Ocean
Southern Ocean

4. Which is the biggest ocean?

WHAT IS AN OCEAN?

Oceans are very large expanses of sea.

There are 7 continents:

Africa
Asia
Europe
Oceania / Australia
North America
South America
Antarctica



DID YOU KNOW ...?

The **Pacific Ocean** is the largest ocean - it covers almost **1/3** of the Earth's **surface**!
