### Class Information:

- Reading Books: Children can choose their reading books and may bring them in from home or choose from the class bookshelf. You may also be interested in looking at the top 100 books for Year 6 as it will give you a guide to the type of books your child should be reading.

#### Homework:

- Spellings each week will be from the Year 3/4 and Y5/6 Spelling lists. Tests will be on Mondays. Practise is to be done on paper and put into their folders.
- Kirfs—your child will have a target highlighted in their diaries which they must practise for a test on Monday. Practise is to be done on paper and put into the homework folders.
- English/Maths worksheets will be due in every Monday
- Reading: your child will be expected to read 4 times a week at home independently and write it in their diaries. Diaries are to be signed by parents each Sunday.
- Phonics: Some children will receive extra phonics work to also be in on Mondays.

All other homework will be kept in their homework folders which must be brought back into school every Monday. Diaries and reading books must be in school everyday.

NOTE: Your child should not spend more than 30mins a night (3 1/2 hours a week) on homework. If it is taking longer please stop and write a note explaining any difficulties in their diary.
