<b>History</b>	<p>This week you will learn about Captain James Cook. Captain Cook is a very famous explorer – you may already know a little but about him as he has links to Whitby, which is a very popular seaside destination, not too far from us.</p> <p>Read through the Information Powerpoint on our class page to learn about Captain James cook.</p>
<b>English/Computing/Art</b>	<p>Think about what it must have been like on board The Endeavour.</p> <p>Use books or the internet to research what it was like on The Endeavour, during its voyages around the world.</p> <p>Draw the ship and an add illustrations and writing to show what you have learnt.</p>
<b>Geography</b>	<p>Using the explorer map on our class page, can you follow the route of Captain Cook's voyage? Can you identify some of the places that he travelled to?</p> <p>Why is Whitby important? Can you find out 5 interesting facts about Whitby?</p>
<b>Art</b>	<p>Have a look at the portrait of Captain Cook below. Can you draw a really careful portrait of him using only a pencil? You will have to think about how you will make light and dark shades.</p>
