By the end of the theme I should be able to:

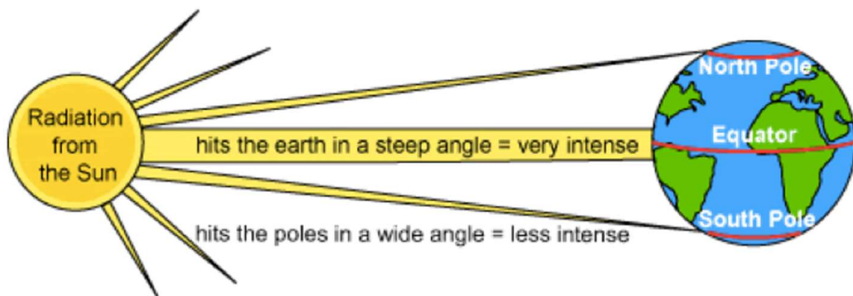
- use world maps and globes to name and locate the seven continents and five oceans;

WHAT IS A CLIMATE?

Climate is the weather in a given place or during a given time.



KEY VOCABULARY

- equator** imaginary line across the centre of the earth
- North Pole** top of the northern hemisphere
- South Pole** bottom of the southern hemisphere
- ocean** a very large body of water
- continents** large areas of land joined together
