Wrap Around Care

As you are aware, I have been looking into providing wraparound care on the school site. The previous provider I had organised did not get enough 'take up' to be financially viable.

We are now hoping to 'team up' with Pre-School, in the hope that this will support families from both settings. We have spoken to a provider, 'Playsafe', who provide care in a number of other settings. In order for this to be viable they would need around 20 children attending each session.

We anticipate that a morning session would operate from 7.30am (to the start of school), currently at a cost of \pounds 9.30^{*}, and after school:

3.15 - 5pm - £11.30*

5.00 - 6pm - an additional £5.75*

* Please note there are a variety of schemes that can help with the costs, such as childcare vouchers and Universal Credit.

In order to proceed, we would need to know approximate numbers / interest.

If you could let us know via the Parentmail form (which will go live shortly) by Friday 14th June, we will be able to proceed with our plans.
