Science	<p><u>Habitat Survey</u></p> <p>Go into your garden or the local park and carry out a habitat survey. Draw a picture of the habitat and note down which living things are part of the habitat.</p>
History	Using words from our 'Romans' topic, create your own word search for someone in your family to complete.
Geography	Research all the flags of the different countries. Draw a flag for each country, colour it in and find out two great facts about each country.
PE	Create your own 'circuit' of activities. You don't need lots of equipment, eg. Lunges, ladder, squats etc. Then involve your family in doing the circuit you have created – take photos if you can.
Art	<p>Hard boil an egg (with adult supervision). Choose a character from a book you have read/are reading and decorate your egg to look like that character. Take a photo of it once you have finished.</p> <p><u>Line</u></p> <p>When we draw, we need to consider the 'line'. This means how thick or thin a line can be. Use your pencil and see how many different types of line you can create. Then get your shoe (that you have drawn previously) and look closely at the 'lines' your shoe has. Now draw your shoe including texture, tone and LINE.</p>
Music	Change the lyrics to your favourite American folk song to create a brand new one.
RE	Choose a religion from any of these: Christianity, Buddhism, Islam, Sikh. Find out as much as you can about the religion you have chosen and make a fact file about it.
