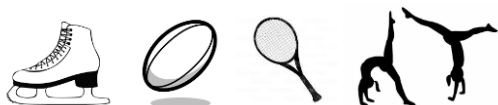

Selby Music Centre is run by North Yorkshire Music Service and has some great opportunities for primary school aged musicians. We are based at Selby High School on **Saturday mornings** in term time and we are able to offer a **FREE** half term of taster sessions, plus the loan of an instrument if needed. In particular, we are offering free lessons on WIND and BRASS instruments this half term! Don't miss this opportunity to learn a new skill!

9.30 – 10.45 **Strings** (violin, viola, cello, bass) and keyboards; **guitar and ukulele** group; NEW **woodwind** (clarinets, recorders, saxophone, flutes) and NEW **brass** (trumpet, cornet, trombone etc)

These groups are suitable for complete beginners, children who have been learning instruments in class at school and more able players up to approx. grade 2 standard.

11.05 – 12.20 Selby Youth Choir - open to all who enjoy singing age 6 upwards; senior strings (grade 2- 5); folk/rock group for guitars who can strum a few chords and more able players on acoustic or electric plus strings and wind players.

All the sessions are friendly and fun, and the children experience a range of music styles and develop their skills and confidence performing in a group.
