English / History / Art	<p><b>Victorian Inventions</b></p> <p>Research the Industrial Revolution that very much changed how Britain looked and worked during Queen Victoria's reign.</p> <p>Choose three new innovations (inventions or changes) and create a fact file all about them – don't forget to tell me who invented or developed them and when. What does it do? How did this change life in Victorian times? Remember to draw a picture or illustrate your work with images from the Internet.</p> <p>Can you identify items we use everyday today that were invented during the Victorian period.? Make a collage of all the things we now have that were introduced during Victoria's reign – (Remember they may have looked very different then)</p> <p>Charles Dickens was a famous writer during the period – many of his books have characters with very odd names – make a list of 20 different characters and then using squared paper make a word search using them. (you might need a lot of squares!)</p>
