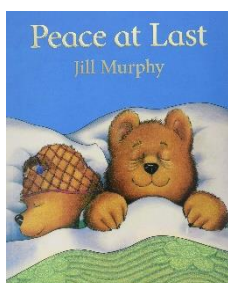

 Can you name them? Retell Mr Bear's story of trying to get to sleep. Write about how you get to sleep at night.

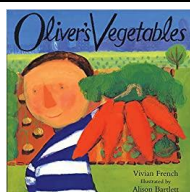
