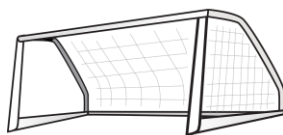

Lateness

We are currently finding that some children are frequently arriving at school late. The school day starts at 8:55am and we expect that all children should be on the playground, lined up as soon as the bell goes so that we can register the class. Children who arrive after the register has closed are given a mark that shows they are in the building but this will NOT count as a present mark and will mean they have an unauthorised absence.

We do recognise that there may be a rare occasion when your child is late due to unforeseen circumstances.

Persistent Lateness

Persistent lateness can add up to considerable amounts of learning lost and can be a serious disadvantage to your child. When a child has been identified as having persistent lateness, we will inform parents/carers of our concerns in the first instance by letter. We will then monitor lateness, expecting to see an improvement.

If this continues to cause concern we will then request a formal meeting to address and resolve issues that are impacting on the child/ren's lateness.

Please be aware that parents/carers can approach us at any time if they are having problems getting their children into school on time. However, as a parent it is your legal responsibility to ensure your child gets to school on time.
