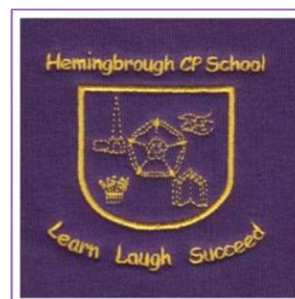

Statutory Assessment
